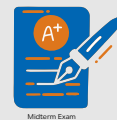

## Disciplinary Actions

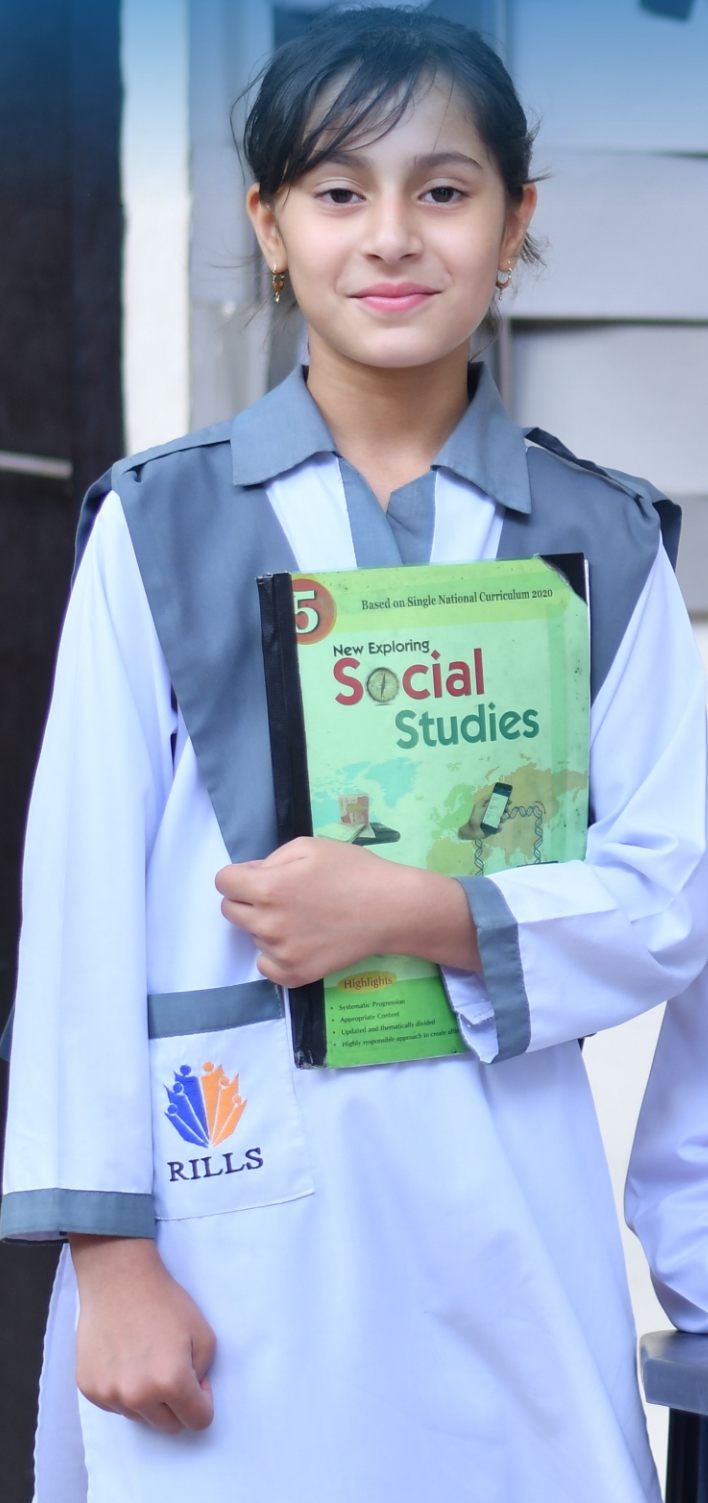

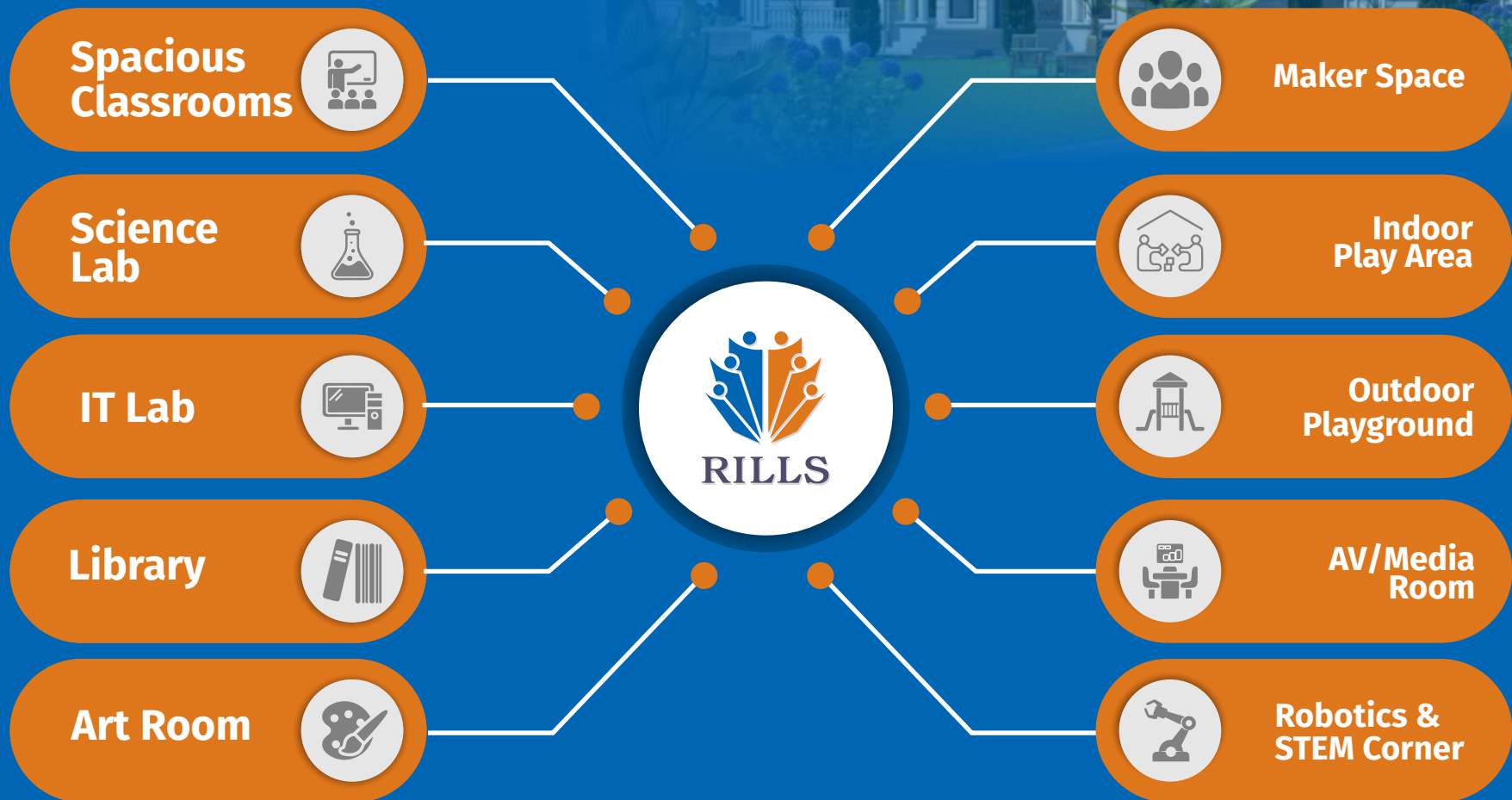

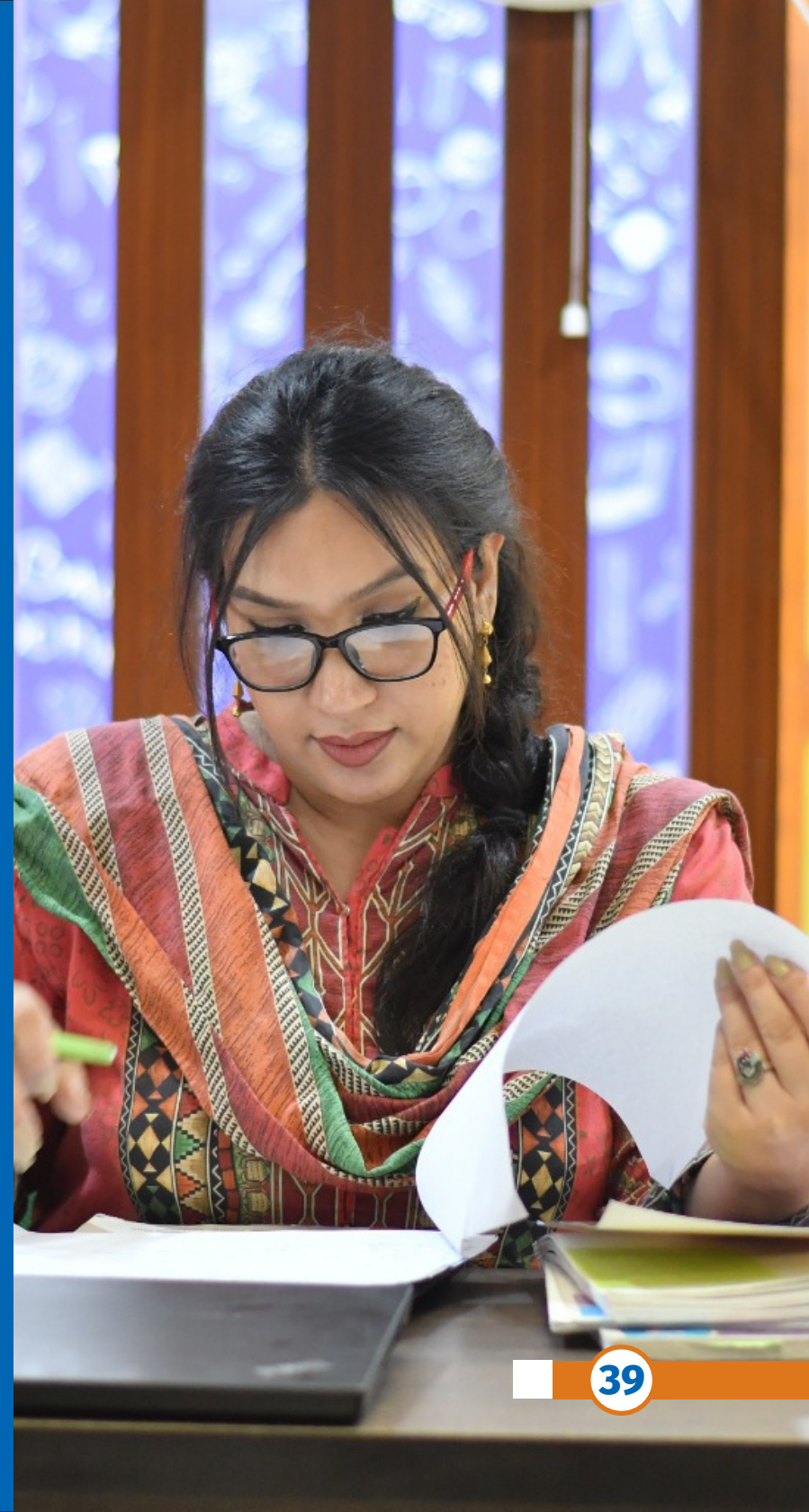
